### **Grant Opportunities**

Fall 2022–Spring 2023

Applications are open to nonprofit entities with 501(c)(3) status, public-facing organizations operating within accredited institutions of higher learning, state and local government agencies, and federally recognized Native American tribal governments in Louisiana. All applicants must have a Unique Entity Identification (UEI) number. Visit [leh.org/grants](http://leh.org/grants) for details.

#### **Currents**

Ready-made book club program incorporating history and memoir. Grants include reading and discussion guides and promotional assets and cover site coordination, facilitator honoraria, book purchases, and program publicity.

Applications Open: Now through October 15, 2022

Award Amount: \$2,400

#### **Emergency Recovery Grants**

Intended to provide rapid relief and/or support longer-term recovery following a disaster. Available to organizations in the 25-parish area declared a federal disaster zone following Hurricane Ida and those organizations impacted by as-yet-unnamed 2022 disasters.

Applications Open: November 1, 2022

Award Amount: Up to \$10,000

#### **Emergency Planning Grants—NEW**

Support the creation, updating, and implementation of written emergency plans.

Applications Open: January 16, 2023

Award Amount: \$5,000

#### **Rebirth Grants**

Programmatic grants that support projects that use the humanities to deepen public understanding of a given topic.

Applications Open: April 1, 2023

Award Amount: Varies based on available funding

#### **Louisiana Culture Care Fund**

General operating support grants designated for operational expenses, including but not limited to staff retention (payroll and benefits), rent, insurance, mortgage, and utilities. Award amounts vary based on annual operating budget of applicant organization.

Applications Open: April 13, 2023

Award Amount: \$5,000–\$15,000
