

Reviewer Evaluation Criteria - 2023 Louisiana Culture Care Fund Grants

All Louisiana Culture Care Fund Grant applications will be subject to the same review process based on the following criteria:

- Eligibility
 - Does the organization meet the eligibility criteria of being a nonprofit with 501(c)(3) status; public-facing organization operating within an accredited institution of higher learning; state or local government agency; or state and federally recognized Native American tribal government in Louisiana?
 - Does the organization have a UEI or DUNS Number?
 - Has the organization provided their most recent form 990 and is in good standing with the IRS?
- Organization's record of humanities-based programming
 - Are the humanities central to the organization's mission?
 - Does the organization have a strong and demonstrated history of humanities programming?
- Alignment with approved use of funds
 - Are unallowable programmatic costs proposed?
- Geographic location (organization must be in one of Louisiana's sixty-four parishes)*
- Organization impact and reach (organization's size, annual audience, town or parish population density)*
 - Does the organization have significant impact in terms of audience numbers in relation to its size and geographic location?
 - Does the organization reach underserved and/or rural regions of the state?
- Organizations who received a 2023 Emergency Planning Grant will be given priority consideration.
